Kindergarten Class Size & Times

Each class has a maximum of 24 children in the room with a certified teacher and an assistant. School begins at 12:15pm and is dismissed at 3:15 Monday through Friday.

The children attend Mass twice a month and participate in monthly outreach experiences and projects. Our kindergarten staff excels in teaching various learning abilities and offers daily reinforcement of basic skills needed to become a successful learner.

Our Curriculum

We teach according to a Diocesan approved comprehensive curriculum. We utilize the Reading Mastery Program, which is a direct instruction, phonics-based initiative. As a result, we have found our students to be very successful readers as they advance in school. The children bring home a weekly newsletter which keeps families aware of what is currently being covered in the classroom. They are exposed to a variety of teaching styles to

St. Timothy Parish Center: Sat, Feb. 4, 9am-noon

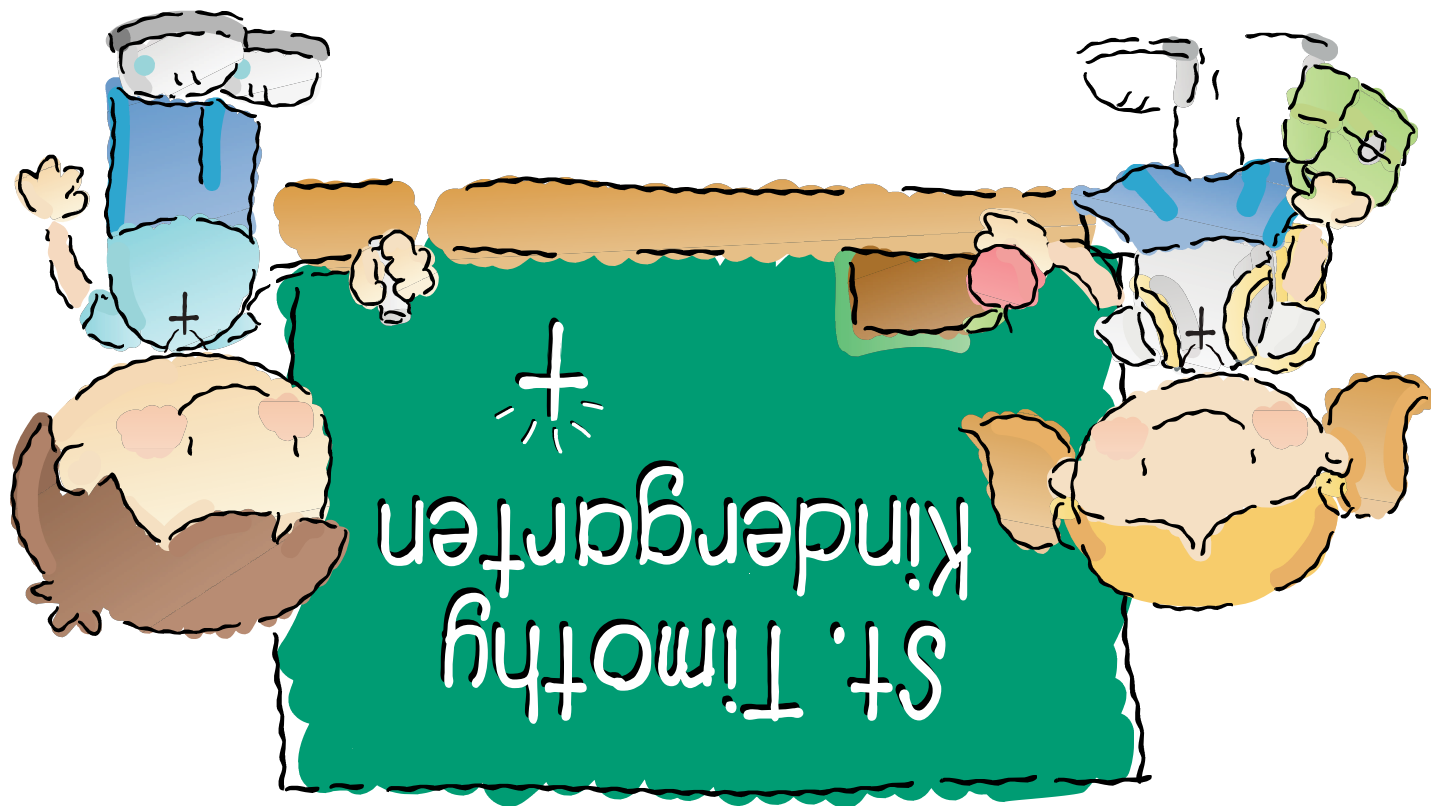
You must bring the following to registration:

- Birth certificate (original)
- Baptismal certificate
- Social security card (original)
- \$10 non-refundable registration fee
- Proof of parish registration (envelope #)



A tuition deposit of \$200 is due upon acceptance. This non-refundable fee will be applied to tuition for 2012/2013. Students entering kindergarten must be five years old by Oct. 1, 2012.

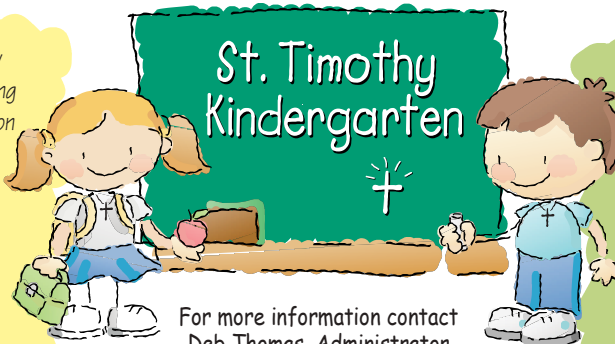
