### Day 1 September 29, Tuesday: Depart USA

Depart Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport via Delta Airlines for our overseas journey to Munich, Germany. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served on board.

# Day 2 September 30, Wednesday: Arrive in Munich

Arrive at Munich International Airport. Proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way tour manager as we exit Customs. Board our private touring bus and we will be on our way to Munich, "Home of the Monks." Munich is the capital of Bavaria and the second largest city in Germany. Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with an excursion to Dachau. Visit the museum in the former administrative buildings of the camp, which gives the visitor an idea of the Nazi concentration camp system. Time will be given for prayer and reflection in Dachau. Independent lunch. Return to Munich.

This afternoon, on your own, you may want to participate in the Oktoberfest activities in Munich.

This evening, enjoy dinner at the Munich Hofbrauhaus.

Overnight at our hotel in Munich.

# Day 4 October 2, Friday: Oberammeragu the Passion Play

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we will check out and drive to visit Wieskirche, the impressive Rococo-era Pilgrimage Church of Wies, designed in the 1740s. Celebrate Mass at Wieskirche. After Mass, we'll continue to the village of Oberamergau, home of the world-famous Passion Play. The play dates back to 1633 when the Plague, the "Black Death", took a severe toll of lives in the small village. In their distress, the inhabitants turned to God and vowed that if the plague were taken from them, they would perform a play every ten years depicting the suffering and death of the Savior. Their plea was heard and there were no further plague victims in Oberammergau. The first performance of the Passion Play took place in 1634 in the village cemetery. Check in at our hotel assigned by the committee of Oberammergau. Independent lunch.

We will attend the Passion Play in the renowned open-air theatre. The greatest story ever told comes to life as this superb production unfolds against a scenic backdrop of wooded mountains. The play begins with Christ's Entry into Jerusalem and the drama continues with the story of Christ's Passion, Death and Resurrection. The accompanying music is magnificent, and a full English translation of the script is available for you to follow from your reserved seat. All the town members partake in this play every 10 years.

There are two parts of the performance.

Part I: 2:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Part II: 8:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m.

The dinner break lasts three hours (dinner is included in Oberammergau arrangements).

Overnight accommodations near Oberammergau.

#### Day 5 October 3, Saturday: Neuschwanstein Castle | Salzburg

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will return to the village of Oberammergau. Time will be given for browsing and shopping. Independent

This afternoon we'll explore King Ludwig's majestic Neuschwanstein Castle, built in 1869. Return to the times of Wagner as we visit the royal apartments decorated with scenes from German sagas and operas; the throne rooms and music halls, with fine candelabras and chandeliers; King Ludwig's unique bedroom with artistic wood carvings; and an artificial Grotto that recalls opera themes of his former friend and composer Richard Wagner.

Late afternoon, continue to the Baroque city of Salzburg, a jewel set on the beautiful

banks of the Salzach River.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Salzburg.

## Day 6 October 4, Sunday: Highlights of Salzburg

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will be transferred to the Shrine of Maria Plain in Salzburg. In 1633, a painting of the Blessed Mother was found undamaged in the ruins of a burned-down wood house. In 1656 a small wooden chapel was built at this location and in 1710 the chapel was rebuilt to house the first copy of the miraculous image. In 1951 Pope Pius XII conferred the title of this Shrine to Basilica Minor. Celebrate Sunday Mass at the Shrine. After Mass, enjoy a highlights tour of Salzburg. Walk along Getreidegasse, the city's pedestrian street, lined with authentic 17th and 18th century buildings. We will stop to visit the house where Mozart was born. After our visit, continue to Salzburg's mountain, Mönchsberg, topped with the fortress Hohensalzburg. Built into the side of Mönchsberg is the Salzburg Festspielhaus, home of the famous Salzburg Festival Operas. See Residenzplatz, the center square of Salzburg, dominated by the largest baroque fountain north of the Alps. Next, visit St. Peter's Abbey, next to the cemetery where The Sound of Music was filmed. Independent lunch and afternoon at leisure. Be sure to explore Salzburg's cafes to try signature treats such as ice coffee or hot chocolate and cake, a tradition that Austrians enjoy. On your own, you might choose to take the cogwheel train up to the mighty Honensalzburg Fortress, the former residence of the powerful Archbishops of Salzburg. From the terrace high above the city, you can enjoy a breathtaking view of the old town. Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Salzburg.

# Day 7 October 5, Monday: Berchtesgaden | Salt Mine |

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Today will provide us with a unique experience! After breakfast at our hotel, we will drive to Berchtesgaden for the Salt Mine tour. The mine brought prosperity to a very poor region when it opened in 1517. The salty rock is washed in water and the resulting brine is piped to a nearby town for refining. On our tour, we will don miner's overalls, take a small train ride, whoosh down wooden slides, and raft across an illuminated lake. Independent lunch.

Our next stop will be the Kehlsteinhaus, or Eagles Nest. Built as a tea house at 6020 feet in elevation on a mountain top, it was a gift to Hitler on his 50th birthday from the Nazi party. It is the only remaining Third-Reich era building. Views extend across the German and Austrian Alps with the glimmering Königssee below. Return to Salzburg. (B,D)

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Salzburg.

## Day 8 October 6, Tuesday: Melk Abbey | Vienna

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Salzburg and drive to upper Austria on our excursion to Melk. Enjoy the magnificent scenery along the Danube in the Wachau region, the pride of the historic preservation movement in Austria. At Melk we will visit the Benedictine Abbey, crowning the rocky hill overlooking the Danube. Its library contains over 80,000 books and 2,000 manuscripts, all on religious subjects. Celebrate Mass at the Abbey. Independent lunch.

Late afternoon, we'll continue to Vienna, the Music Capital of the World! Vienna is the city of Mozart, Beethoven, Brahms, and Strauss! We will stay for two nights in Vienna. Independent dinner.

Overnight at our hotel in Vienna.

#### Day 9 October 7, Wednesday: Imperial Vienna Schonbrunn Palace

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Today we'll visit the most important historical sights of Vienna, beginning with 8:30 a.m. Mass at St. Stephen's Cathedral. After Mass, we'll tour the Cathedral. Austria's most eminent Gothic edifice houses a wealth of art treasures and is dedicated to St. Stephen, the first martyr of Christendom. Then, continue our orientation tour as we pass by the Hofburg Palace, winter residence of the Habsburg emperors; the Capuchin Church, which contains the imperial vaults; St. Charles' Church, a splendid example of late Baroque architecture; and the Belvedere Palace, former residence of Prince Eugene of Savoy. Drive around the Ring, one of the most magnificent boulevards in the world, passing the Vienna Opera, museums, House of Parliament, City Hall, and the Burgtheater. Independent lunch.

We will have an extended tour of the Schonbrunn Palace, the summer residence of the Habsburgs. It came into its full grandiose splendor during the reign of Maria Theresa, when she added the massive mirrors, frescoed ceilings, and gigantic crystal chandeliers. Enjoy the balance of the day at leisure to explore the city. You could view Mozart's memorial; walk along the famous Kärntner Strasse, a pedestrian area where glamorous stores line the sidewalks; take a ride in a horse-drawn coach; or wander along the winding streets of the old city. This evening, enjoy a special farewell Heurigen dinner with entertainment at

Zum Martin Sepp restaurant in Grinzing.
