

**ST. TIMOTHY PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL**  
**December 12, 2012 Meeting**

Phil Sheehy called the meeting to order. Previous minutes approved and seconded. Pete Freeman opened the meeting with a prayer

Received Reports from the Outreach Committee, Adult Faith Formation, Education Committee, Worship Committee, Community Committee and Youth Faith Formation

Paul Stratman reported that Karen Reigler asked if someone could speak from Sacred Heart radio; can advertise in bulletin only. Fr. Bolte to do a scripture study on Vatican documents after the first of the year.

**FINANCES**

Fr. Bolte gave an update on the Finance Committee. The Finance Committee has been undergoing an audit and working on 6-8 issues that were raised. Being that FDIC only insures up to \$250,000 in an account, it was suggested that St. Tim use other banks. Discussion followed on the different accounts available. The Finance Committee will ultimately work with Fr. Bolte to diversify funds.

Water main break in November cost \$7500. Purchased a genie lift to change light bulbs (\$8000)-gifted.

**BAPTISMAL FONT:** The committee has submitted new drawings for the baptismal font. The font would have wooden sides, mosaic and marble inside. The font would be built for immersion baptisms, but the designer is working on making the font not look like a Jacuzzi.

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS:** Funds have been received for the new stations. Fr. Bolte is working with Terry Dunn on the finalization of the stations.

**ST. TIMOTHY SCHOOL:** Fr. Bolte has been in contact with a parish in Indiana who started a school. The pastor in Indiana sent Fr. Bolte documentation that they used in planning the school and have been very helpful. Fr. Bolte feels that the study they did will be a great template for helping the feasibility study that is required by the diocese. St. Timothy will start with grades 1-5 and expand to with grades 6-8. The planning committee is working with Fr. Bolte.

**ST. TIMOTHY CHOIR:** There has been discussion between Fr. Bolte and Katie Barton relative to the choir. Due to the size of the choir that grown under the direction of Katie, more room is needed. It was discussed that Katie would move the piano and choir behind the sanctuary. There would need to be some sort of lattice work that would keep the choir from becoming a distraction. It is unsure if there is enough room for the choir. It may be necessary to use the choir members for other Masses. Fr. Bolte will continue discussions with Katie. It was noted that Katie Barton does a wonderful job with the choir and the music ministry.
