MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: Phil Sheehy called the meeting to order. August minutes were approved.

OPENING PRAYER: Erica Kohlman opened the meeting with a prayer

SCHOOL

Discussion of the September meeting with Bishop Foys regarding a school at St. Timothy. Paul Stratman, Paul Melihercik, Pete Freeman voiced their opinions that they felt that the bishop is agreeable to a school at St. Timothy. All other council members agreed on this point. Paul Stratman felt that it was time to get the "sand under the wheels". Fr. Bolte will move forward with creating a steering committee and working with Mike Clines in order to determine what type of feasibility study that we should now undertake. A vote was taken and everyone agreed to the steering committee. Fr. Bolte would like someone from the Parish Council to be part of the steering committee, as a liaison between the two. No member at the meeting volunteered to be part of the steering committee.

FINANCE: No Report since there was no September meeting due to the meeting with Bishop Foys.

EDUCATION: Terry Dunn submitted the St. Timothy Preschool/Kindergarten Pillar Report.

COMMUNITY: Nicole Grosser submitted a report on the Oktoberfest. Final numbers were not yet available, but felt that deposits were up from last year and they were expecting final numbers to be better than 2011.

PASTOR'S REPORT: Terry Dunn has resigned and now parish council only has 8 members instead of 9, there are no alternatives, as Paul Stratman one the only alternative and he has already filled a vacancy. Paul Stratman will replace Terry Dunn on the Education committee.

Around \$10,000 has been collected for the Stations. The cost was estimated to be between \$18,000 to \$25,000.

Baptismal Font Saga continues Fr. Bolte has gone back to the basic design, marble top, mosaic inside, which would consist of a starburst, host and flame. The problem is that there is no local person who can do the mosaic work. The goal is to stay within the budget of \$30-40,000.
